New Gear for LCHS



Knowledge Bowl received money for a new timing system and Drama received money for a portion of their new LED light system in the auditorium. Several other teams plan to revisit their needs especially on uniforms in the next school year.

The next allocation meeting will be in early September - the first Booster Club meeting of the 2019-2020 school year - with a budget of \$12,900. 
