- Wrestling - New coach has not been hired yet but they are working on it.

- Auction went well. Est profit - \$32,151. Biggest items were the 2 parking spaces donated by the district. \$2500 x 2.
- Parents rallied and came to the event – sold 103 tickets.
- Tom Sherry did a great job and is inexpensive - \$800 for the event. Other auctioneers charge double or triple that price.
- Event space was discussed. Overall opinion was positive on the venue.

Vice President's Report – Erica Traxler

- Allocation Meeting
 - Baseball – requesting \$2594. Have \$2757 in choice dollars
 - Need c-team uniforms. Varsity will get new uniforms – life expectancy 10 years
 - Balls
 - Fielding 65 players this year.
 - Boys Basketball – requesting \$2521. Have \$376 in choice dollars.
 - Warm-up Jerseys
 - Balls – same as those used at state tourney with the tiger paw logo
 - Team fundraising – summer youth sports camp with 230 kids
 - Total needing vote - \$2145
 - Marcus supports both allocations. Motion to approve - Travis Flores, 2nd - Andi Koslowsky
- Additional discussions
 - Where do teams get funds if not from Boosters? The District allocates funds to each team. Does not count towards travel outside of district. Most of the money is spent on getting to and from games.
 - Choice Dollars
 - Money earned from concessions is divided into choice dollars for those teams with the volunteers. Average \$55/per session.
 - Dollar's available current school year and will roll for 1 year. (2 year total)
